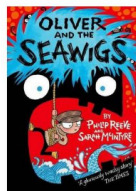


Christian Value- Compassion

History – Tudor Monarchs

An aspect of British history extending past 1066

- a study of an aspect or theme in British history that extends pupils' chronological knowledge beyond 1066.

Science- Sound and Hearing

- Identify how sounds are made, associating some of them with something vibrating
- recognise that vibrations from sounds travel through a medium to the ear
- find patterns between the pitch of a sound and features of the object that produced it
- find patterns between the volume of a sound and the strength of the vibrations that produced it

- Learn and be able to recall some key Tudor facts from history in French.

MATHS- Whiterose

- Use factor pairs
- Multiply and divide by 10 or 100
- Informal written methods for multiplication
- Estimate and use inverse operations to check answers
- Know all tables to 12 x12
- Multiply and divide mentally
- Use standard short multiplication to multiply two and three –digit numbers by a one-digit number
- Solve problems involving multiplying and dividing
