



SCHOOL UNIFORM AND PRESENTATION POLICY

Care, **respect** and **positivity** serve as our spiritual 'uniform' that creates belonging among our community.

All children should wear our *full correct school uniform*. We are very proud of our uniform and our children must wear it smartly to represent our school. Our **new logo school uniform** is available from Bispham Clothing located in Bispham village. Optional items such as school fleeces are also available from this store.

It is essential that all items of your child's clothing are **clearly named** to avoid misplacement or loss. This is especially important in classes in KS1 who change for PE within school, where items can get muddled up.

Jewelry

- Plain, small stud earrings only (these **must** be removed for any PE lesson). Please ensure that they are **taken out at home** on PE/swimming/extra-curricular club days as staff are unable to remove them for the child and therefore participation in lessons would be affected.) The children **cannot use plasters** to cover earrings. Where possible, please avoid having your child's ears pierced during school time as this has a detrimental effect on many sessions of PE learning. *The beginning of the summer holidays is the perfect time.*
- Rings/bracelets/smart watches/necklaces **are not allowed** (with the exception of medical/religious reasons – please discuss with the head teacher in these circumstances)

Hairstyling

- Please ensure that hair styling is appropriate. (**no Mohicans/hair dying**)
- No large headbands/bows/clips. Any headwear should be the school colours: whites and blues.
- Long hair should be **tied back at all times** and off the face area.

Fleeces

- Fleeces can be worn as a jacket outside in colder weather; however, jumpers should be worn inside.

Footwear

- **Black** sensible school shoes – **no trainers** (unless for PE)
- No heels or loose-fitting shoes to be worn for health and safety purposes.
