Maths

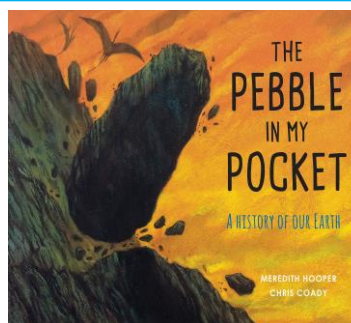
- Counting, sequences and multiplication.
